Marion is selling her CD of the Nicholson Cemetery and all the names who are buried there. She researched and found that 178 people are buried in the cemetery without stones. All of the names with stones and without stones are listed in her CD. Marion will charge \$20.00 a CD and the proceeds will go to the Nicholson Heritage Association.
